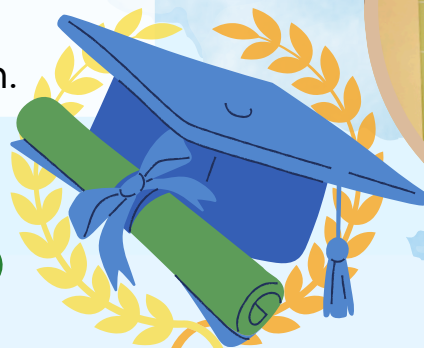
Introduction to Day Camp Course
